1. God's passionate heart, changes everything, in Christ alone. Luke 19:38
 - A. The cries of the crowd change from 'Hosanna' to 'Crucify.'
 - B. Grace changes us from broken to restored. Philippians 2:5,11
2. God's passionate heart, is all we need, in Christ alone. Luke 19:31,34
 - A. God's grace makes known all God's needs.
 - B. God's greatest need this week, for eternity, is you.
3. God's passionate heart, beats the crowd, in Christ alone. Luke 23:40-47
 - A. Peer pressure began long ago, and echoes through the ages.
 - B. The power of One gives power to be God's faithful ones. Luke 19:40
4. God's passionate heart, fulfills mission and salvation, in Christ alone.
 - A. Jesus knew the mission ahead, and still goes forward, to face Satan, to beat Satan, to tear that kingdom down. Philippians 2:7-9
 - B. Trust The One keeping his heart on us, is forever faithful, passionate, powerful, peaceful, overflowing, compassionate, driven, leaving room for God's grace and passion alone, to save you! Luke 23
