Draw lines connecting the opposites.



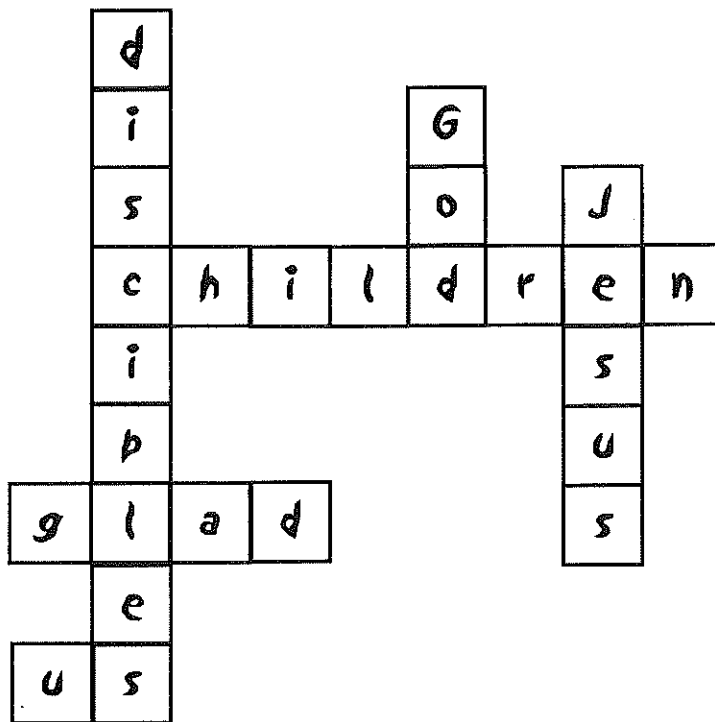
