While being king is a great honor, the position is best fulfilled by those who honor their calling with great wisdom and insight. In those lands ruled by kings, it is a great honor to know the king, to be known, recognized, by the king. In Mark's Gospel today, Jesus Christ our King makes it clear, his Kingdom is not of this world. As we celebrate Christ The King Sunday, let us celebrate and affirm and give all thanks to God, for we know The King personally, and the King affirms each of us, and we are known personally by The King and recognized by The King, and we live in the Kingdom of glory and grace forever!**
